



Belize Island Adventure - Best of Water Sports

Day 1-

Arrive excited and full of anticipation at the Belize International Airport before heading to a nearby Plaza Hotel for orientation, dinner, and a good night's rest. Enjoy the beautiful view for the Swing Bridge in downtown Belize City.

Day 2-

Enjoy breakfast with your group before walking the two blocks to a private dock. Board the boat and meet your captain before departing for Long Caye. Enjoy views of the open sea crossing between the Belize Barrier Reef and Glover's reef and cross at Tobacco Caye. Don't worry if you encounter swells and spray along the way, enjoy the ride and take in the fresh air; perhaps you might catch sight of dolphins on your way out to the atoll.



Arrive on the island, unload the boat and enjoy a sumptuous, homemade lunch. Get settled into your private cabana before having a snorkeling orientation and go for your first dip right off the shore. Snorkel as much as your heart desires while here, whenever the mood strikes or with the group excursions scheduled throughout the days.

Day 3-

Wake up and set in for a sea kayak orientation. First will be an introduction on the beautiful beaches and then a practice session in the water. After lunch, follow one guide for group paddling to a nearby patch reef to snorkel from the kayaks, or go with another guide offering windsurfing instruction. The waters are yours to explore, whether riding the wind from above or delving to see its depths. Certified divers may also begin diving, and those who want to try their hand at fishing can fish anytime. Your fishing license is included in the trip, and this is the only fishing kayak fleet in all of Belize.





Day 4-

The first discover scuba course is offered this morning for beginner divers. Gain valuable skills to make your trips beneath the surface a wonderful, unforgettable experience with amazing sights. Others enjoy a morning paddle. Both windsurfing lessons and the kayak surfing orientation are offered in the afternoon.

With near-constant breeze and a perfect set of waves breaking just off our shore, anytime is perfect for a number of watersports. Surf boards are also provided so surfer can get great action.



Day 5-

Paddle five miles round-trip to Middle Caye to tour the Marine Research Center, base for visiting marine biologists. Or, choose to stay on the island trying out your new water sport skills. With a buddy you can sea kayak, snorkel, surf kayak, windsurf, surf, or just relax. Kite boarders can also use the equipment they brought with them at any time, or take kite surfing lessons at the new kite surf school.



Day 6-

Begin with a kayak rolling lesson followed by a snorkel around the island. Enjoy the beauty of the beach and the turquoise waters before you depart, just after lunch, arriving in Belize City by 3 - 5 p.m.



The cost of this trip is \$1295 US per person

This trip includes: first night hotel and island accommodations, transports mentioned and most meals, cold beer, soda, juice, and water on the island, all kayaks, windsurfers, surf kayaks, surf boards, and accessories, and sea kayaking, windsurfing, surf kayaking, and snorkeling instruction, beginning kitesurfing instruction, daily guided activities, staff members fees, Glover's park entrance fees, fishing license fees for fishermen, complimentary t-shirt

This trip does not include: flights to and from Belize, taxis to and from Belize International Airport, fees and equipment for scuba diving, fees, insurance, instruction, and equipment for advanced kitesurfing, snorkeling gear (mask, fins, and snorkel, wet suit or dive skin), fishing gear (fishing kayaks are provided), Belize departure tax: approx. \$35, travel, meals, or accommodations after returning to Belize City
