Whales, Dolphins, and Sea Lions Tour

February 6-11; February 13-18; February 20-25; February 27- March 3;
March 5-10; March 6-11; March 12-17; March 13-17; March 19-24; March 26-31

Day 1

Begin your adventure at by meeting at San Diego Brown field at 7:00 am, with your flight departing at 8:00 am. Fly to either Ensenda or San Felipe and see the Pacific Coast and the Sea of Cortez while searching the water for whales. Reach Laguna Ojo De Libre (Scammons Lagoon), the largest and most populated of the 3 calving grounds of the California Grey whale. Spend your afternoon at the Parque de Ballenas Gris where you will enjoy your first amazing sights whale watching. A delicious lunch and dinner will be served in your private house, where only the members of your group will be staying, in the small Mexican town of Guerrero Negro. Partake in an optional Mexican cooking class this night.



Day 2

Learn about the Viscaino Biosphere Reserve, the largest in Latin America, and the Ballenas Gris (Grey Whale) followed by a whale watch trip in Laguna Ojo De Libre and a picnic lunch. Enjoy nature walks, bicycling, exploring Guerrero Negro, or more whale watching in Parque de Ballenas de Gris (back of the Lagoon) this afternoon.

Day 3

After whale watching and an afternoon picnic lunch, board your private aircraft for an aerial tour of Laguna Ojo de Libre, the Midriff Island region, and the Sea of Cortez. Pass numerous islands by boat en route to Las Animas Wilderness Lodge, set in a crescent shaped bay, this afternoon. Enjoy the untouched, pristine wilderness while staying in your own beachside yurt. Enjoy Mexican meals freshly prepared by private chefs.



Day 4 & 5

Explore the region by both land and water as you enjoy access to sea kayaks, motorized boats, and hiking trails. Hiking will take you through the open desert terrain, noticing the vegetation and desert foliage that go right up to the waters' edge. Enter the canal de Ballenas (whale canal) in search of a resident population of Fin whales, the second longest whale in the entire world or take out a sail boat at your leisure. Snorkel with and observe sea lions, watch dolphins play and possibly view several more types of whales.



Day 6

Depart Las Animas mid morning. Watch sea birds and marine mammals en route to Bahia de Los Angeles, and visit the local museum. The return flight travels along the Sea of Cortez with in-flight lunch to San Diego. Arrive at Brown field approx. 5:00 PM.



The trip costs \$2,495 per person plus taxes

The trip includes: all meals, drinks (alcoholic and non-alcoholic), airfare from San Diego, accommodations, many activities are included

The trip does not include: 12% Mexican IVA tax, airfare to San Diego
